ORDER

Upon consideration of the Plaintiff's Motion for an Expedited Preliminary Injunction, the pleadings, relevant law, related legal memoranda and arguments of counsel in opposition and support, and the entire record of this case, for the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiff's [3] Motion for an Expedited Preliminary Injunction is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants, their agents, employees, and successors in office are hereby enjoined from enforcing COVID-19-related restrictions as to Capitol Hill Baptist Church (the "Church") insofar as they prevent the Church from holding socially-distanced, outdoor worship services in which congregants wear masks.

SO ORDERED.
